RE: Presumptive Maximum Amounts Adjustment for July 1, 2005

Pursuant to NRS 125B.070 (3), it is the responsibility of the State Court Administrator to determine the amount of the increase or decrease in presumptive maximum amounts, establish the adjusted amounts to take effect on July 1 of each year, and notify all district courts of the adjusted amounts.

The increase in the Consumer Price Index (All Items) published by the United States Department of Labor for the calendar year 2004 (copy attached) was 3.3%. Based upon this increase, the presumptive maximum amounts that will become effective on July 1, 2005 are:
