

**Badrain v. Badrain, No. 61557, Order Affirming in Part, Reversing in Part and Remanding (Unpublished Disposition, Mar. 4, 2016)

When receiving Social Security Disability Benefits while having a child support obligation, you can request to have the children's benefits that are paid as a result of your disability applied to your child support obligation. However, any payment by Social Security over the controlling child support amount can only be applied to arrearages that are accrued AFTER you became eligible for the disability payments.
