Adult certification may be based on either the seriousness of the offenses or a juvenile's past adjudications alone; alternatively, in close cases, the juvenile court may consider a juvenile's personal subjective factors, in conjunction with other factors.

The record indicates the juvenile court adequately considered the aforementioned relevant factors , and thus this court cannot conclude that the district court's decision to grant the State's certification petition was an abuse of discretion.
