Under Old Aztec Mine a point not raised at trial is deemed to be waived. Thus, such points will not be considered on appeal and cannot provide a basis for reversal.

Per NRCP 61, courts shall disregard any error or defect in the proceeding which does not affect the substantial rights of the parties. Here, the only harm raised by the husband is is the limitation on his ability to get information regarding property in Brazil and money that he allegedly given his wife to build the property. Due to his failure to appear at trial and his waiver of arguments regarding the aforementioned property, any error in the court's rulings are harmless.
